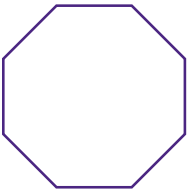
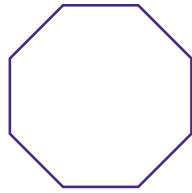
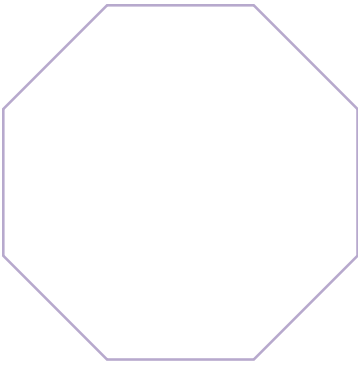

April 2014 marked the 70th anniversary of Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation's beginning, and we have much to celebrate throughout our decades' long history. I am privileged to be of service to the Foundation, and am pleased to share with you highlights from our 2013-2014 year.

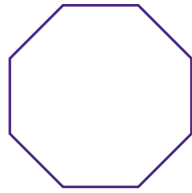
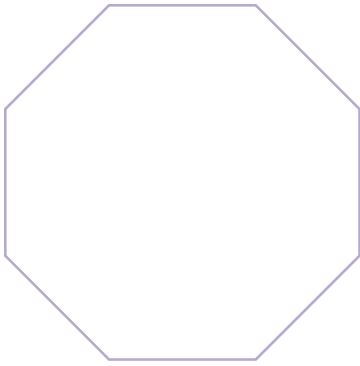
- The Scholarship Committee awarded \$205,600 to more than 200 undergraduates and five graduate fratres, plus 10 scholarships for daughters of Σ AM members or members of United Synagogue Youth or North American Federation of Temple Youth. - The Foundation provided grants in excess of \$55,000 to Sigma Alpha Mu Fraternity to support educational programs for students. These programs educate students on relevant issues such as hazing prevention, alcohol and substance abuse awareness, and ethical leadership training.
- Ten chapters or individuals received Jewish Endeavor Initiative funds. The activities supported with these grants ranged from Hebrew Hoops, a basketball camp for children founded by a student at our Mu Theta/USC chapter to campus-wide Shabbat dinners for chapters.

Our Foundation leads similar Greek organizations in the level of scholarship funding we provide. We can do this because you and other donors give generously to the annual fund and for special appeals plus many donors endow funds for scholarships or other awards.

Your gifts directly benefit our undergraduate and graduate fratres. We are thankful for your continued commitment to Sigma Alpha Mu and the role we have in developing leaders for tomorrow.

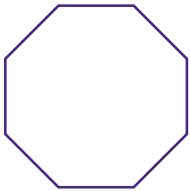

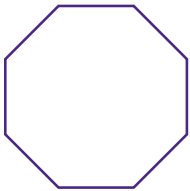


Who We Are

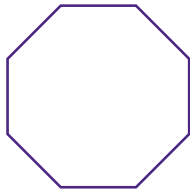
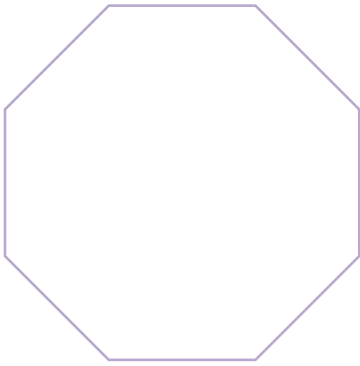


What We Did 2013-2014



The Foundation funded more than \$260,000 in programs that reached more than 2,000 students during 2013-14. This includes \$205,600 in scholarships and academic recognitions awards for students and more than \$55,000 in grants for leadership development, men's health education, community service, and Jewish programming.

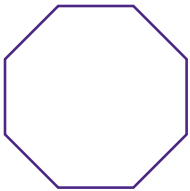

Scholarships & Academic Recognition Awards

The Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation was founded to provide financial aid to student fratres and recognize outstanding scholarship. Our Scholarship and Academic Recognition Awards continue to be the Foundation's largest program. The Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation distributed a record \$205,600 to graduate and undergraduate recipients; this included \$36,800 to 92 Young Scholars. The Young Scholars initiative recognizes Sigma Alpha Mu candidates who achieve a 3.75 during their candidate term with a \$400 award based on need and merit. Our endowed scholarship program awarded \$168,800 to 134 students. The need for scholarships to help provide access to higher education is growing – tuition, fees, room and board and other expenses can amass to more than \$50,000 per year for an undergraduate education; today's undergraduates have an average of \$22,000 in debt before graduation. 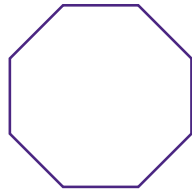
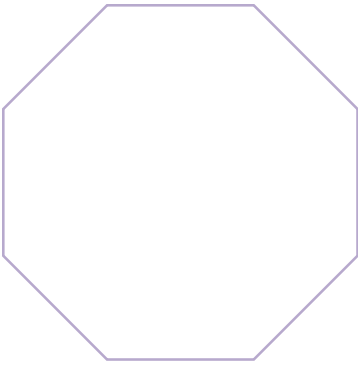
During the 2013-2014 academic year the Foundation provided programming grants to non-profit, educational and charitable organizations totaling \$55,399. These grants supported leadership development, community service, men's health education, academic achievement programs that reached more than 2,000 students.

GreekLifeEDU:

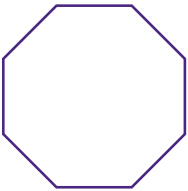
All Sigma Alpha Mu candidates are provided the GreekLifeEdu online education program prior to their initiation into the Fraternity. This program provides students information and tools to make better decisions regarding campus health issues including hazing, alcohol, sexual relations. Results are measured and data shows better long term decision making for students participating in this program. The Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation funded 100 percent of the GreekLifeEdu program for Sigma Alpha Mu candidates through a grant to the Fraternity of \$14,500.

What We Did 2013-2014



A special fund provides for leadership development programs, educational materials and the **Guller Scholars Program at Leadership Conference or Convention**. Since its inception in 1985, the Guller Fund has reached thousands of young fratres with programs on scholarship, personal development, health issues and numerous other worthwhile topics. A special thanks to Fra Sidney Guller whose vision and generosity created the Bobbi & Sidney Guller Leadership Development Fund to endow this program.

Chapter Leaders Day: The Foundation makes an annual grant to support this intense one-day program for chapter leadership. Topics covered include goal setting and strategic planning, leadership and team building and conflict resolution. The 2014 grant for Chapter Leaders day to the ΣAM Fraternity funded leadership training for chapter Priors, Vice Priors, Exchequers, Recorders, Candidate Educators, and emerging leaders at six regional programs. A special thanks to Fras Irwin Jacobs (Cornell '51), David Rice (Wisconsin/Illinois Chicago '83) and Aaron Girson (Western Michigan '92) whose generosity created the endowment to support this program.

Community Service Program: Fratres visited the Holocaust Museum in Washington D.C. and past Supreme Prior Phillip Glauben spoke at a luncheon about his father's experiences as a Holocaust survivor.

Chapter Visitation Program: A grant of more than \$50,000 to Sigma Alpha Mu Fraternity funded educational and leadership development programs, including professional staff visits to chapters and colonies.

HazingPrevention.org: An unrestricted grant to this charity that focuses on educating high school and college students on the dangers and negative impact of hazing.

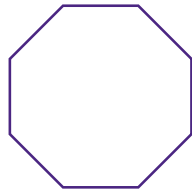
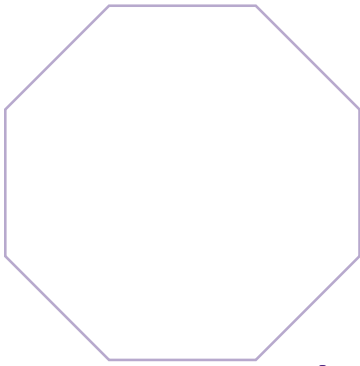

The Gamma Kappa/Texas A&M chapter received an honorable mention for their outstanding participation.

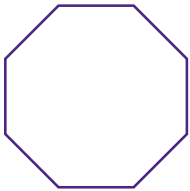
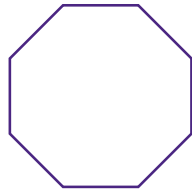
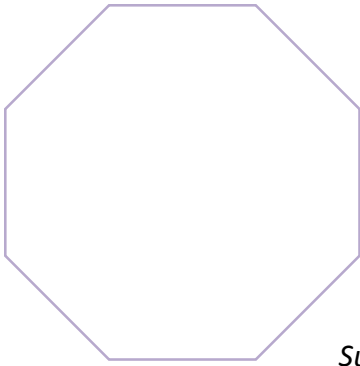

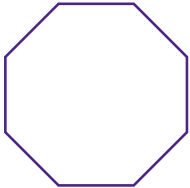

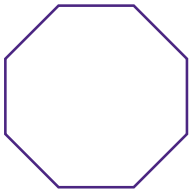
