Unlike many Greek organizations, the Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation is proud to offer several scholarships to fratres who were active as undergraduates and are now pursuing graduate degrees. Highlights include:


Michael Contillo (Pennsylvania, '09) is working on a joint JD and MBA at Harvard University and is editor of the Harvard Law Business Review. He is the 2016 recipient of the **Chief Justice Norman Krivosha Scholarship** is for a member of Σ AM attending law school (2-3rd year) and demonstrating excellence. Fra Krivosha (Nebraska, '54) served as Chief Justice of the Nebraska Supreme Court from 1979-1987.

Dr. Lewis Hare (Syracuse, '28) after serving as a captain in the Army during WWII, had a thriving medical practice in Chicago for many years. He and his wife, Ruth, endowed the **Dr. Lewis Hare Scholarship** for a member of Σ AM in medical school. The 2016 recipient, **Dustin Massel** (Illinois, '08), is in medical school at the University of Miami and intends to go into orthopedics. His research was on total knee replacement was published in the Journal of Arthroplasty and he is a past Samuel Miller Research Award recipient.

The 2016 recipients of the **Gormin Family Scholarships** are **Vince Michalec** and **David Conway**. Vince (Rochester, '12) who is pursuing his JD degree at Univ of Akron. David (Miami University, '11) is a past Vice Prior of his chapter and is in veterinary school at The Ohio State University. These scholarships were endowed by past Supreme Prior Gary Gormin (Minnesota, '62) and his sons Jonathan (Leigh, '90) and Daniel (Wisconsin, '94). Josh Steinberg (Arizona, '08) is studying dentistry at AT Still University School of Dentistry and is the recipient of the Nu Legacy Scholarship. Josh is the grandson of Milton Setnar (Buffalo, '52). Alumni of Nu chapter have created this scholarship for the children and grandchildren of Nu alumni who are undergraduates or graduate students. Theda & Leonard Leventhal Scholarship is for a graduate student who is a Boy Scout with Star, Life or Eagle rank. 

Memorial Scholarships



The Ben Anderson Memorial Scholarship was created by alumni from the North Carolina State/Sigma Omega chapter to memorialize Ben Anderson, an amazing part of the history of the chapter. Ben Anderson was hired as the cook for the Sigma Omega Chapter at North Carolina State University in Raleigh, NC, in 1948 after having served in the U.S. Army. He became both a brother who shared in the daily adventures of the members as well as a father figure who dispensed wonderful advice if one had a problem. Ben retired in 1972, but he still maintained a close relationship with the Chapter. To honor Ben, two generations of Sigma Omegans endowed this scholarship. **Jason Chavenson** (Epsilon Delta, '13) is the 2016 recipient of the scholarship. All the more fitting, Jason is in the culinary program and Captain of the Johnson & Wales tennis team.

Juan Rogriguez-Behar is the recipient of the **Gary Cotlieb** Memorial Scholarship, which was created to remember Gary (Texas, '86), a vibrant and outgoing member of the chapter and his pledge class. Awarded to a member of the Sigma Theta/Texas chapter who demonstrates leadership, financial need and academic distinction, Juan serves as Social Chair for the Sigma Theta chapter and is majoring in economics. Thanks to the efforts of fratres, family and UT alumni, this scholarship fund continues to grow.

The Andrew Dickson Memorial Scholarship was endowed by family and friends to remember Andy Dickson (Washington University, '83) and his outstanding brotherhood and friendship. Andy's mother, sisters and friends have remained involved and continue to make this scholarship a priority. Each year the amount of the scholarship and the number of applicants has increased. In 2016 this was awarded to **Bryce Ericksen** (Gamma Kappa, '14), who was nominated for this scholarship by Jordan Argamany, his roommate. Jordan cited Bryce's a humble and caring nature and willingness to drop what he's doing at a minute's notice to help those he cares about in need. Bryce is a finance major, and has served as Social Chair and Alumni Recorder for the chapter.

In addition, for 2016 there was an **Honorable Mention Andrew Dickson Scholarship** recipient who received a \$1,000 scholarship. This was **Jake Sidransky** (Mu Epsilon, '13), who has served as both Prior and Recruitment Chair for his chapter. Jake has been repeatedly nominated by the fratres of his chapter for his leadership.

Memorial Scholarships

The **Steven Dachinger Memorial Scholarship** was endowed by his family and friends to remember Steven and honor his loyalty, leadership and dedication to Sigma Alpha Mu. Fra Dachinger was initiated at Mu Chi/Michigan State and transferred to Sigma Gamma/Tulane and was part of the brotherhood of both chapters. The recipient should be someone who exemplifies Steven's sense of honor, humor and commitment to both university and leadership. The 2016 recipient is **Randall Burke** (Gamma Phi, '13), a Jewish Studies major who is involved with Stand With Us and Hillel on campus.

The Jonathan A. Schmidt Memorial

Scholarship, was first dedicated in April 2013 by the Schmidt family and the Delta Theta/SUNY Stony Brook chapter. A biomedical engineering major, Jonathan was a loyal member of the Delta Theta chapter, and the chapter continues to honor his memory by participating in an annual walk with his family as Team Jonathan and holding a campus-wide softball tournament. Joseph LaSpina (Delta Theta, '14) is the 2016 recipient of the Jonathan A. Schmidt Scholarship and serves as IFC President as well as Recruitment Chair for the chapter. Jonathan still remains a part of Delta Theta Chapter in spirit and the family supports both this scholarship fund and cancer treatment though the efforts of Team Jonathan each year.

The family of Jeff Levy (Texas, '80) has endowed the **Jeff Levy Memorial Scholarship** for a member of the Sigma Theta chapter at Texas as a tribute to Fra Levy's experiences in Σ AM and the friends he made in the chapter. **Alex Berger** (Sigma Theta, '13) received the scholarship for 2016 and has served the chapter in various offices, including Athletic Chair. Just like Jeff, Alex is cited by his friends as always being ready for a game of basketball. Neil Macrini (Mu Eta, '15), a Photo, Film & Video major, is the recipient of the Michael J Weiss Memorial Scholarship, endowed by Foundation Director Robert Weiss (Oklahoma, '75) in memory of his brother Michael (Oklahoma, '75). Together they also endowed the Weiss Brothers Scholarship for daughters of fratres.

The Sigma Alpha Mu Foundation is fortunate to be able to honor our heritage with a variety of scholarships for students majoring or minoring in Jewish Studies. In memory of his parents Paul (Nebraska, '51) & Margie Alperson, Joel Alperson (Texas, '78) endowed a scholarship - Yonatan Krakow (Beta, '15) is the 2016 Margie & Paul Alperson Scholarship recipient. In addition to minoring in Jewish Studies, Yoni is involved with other Jewish activities on campus.

Past Supreme Prior Sidney Guller (Washington University, '43), in addition to creating the Guller Young Scholars program, has endowed four other scholarships for fratres: The Martin E. Sherman Scholarship honors the good deeds Fra Sherman (Missouri, '58) did for Σ AM, the Sigma Rho chapter and St. Louis fratres; the Louis & Fannie Guller Scholarship is a memorial to the parents of Sidney, and his brothers Arthur (Missouri, '54) & Maurice (Missouri, '54), and grandparents of Robert Guller (Texas, '86) and James Guller (Theta, '81); the Bobbi & Sidney Guller Scholarship remembers Sidney's late wife Bobbi and how she shared Sidney's dedication to Fraternity; and the Sidney Guller Scholarship, which is intended for Phi/Washington University, shows Sidney's continued devotion to his college and Fraternity.

Each student receives a certificate and an award of \$500. This program is funded through the generosity of Past Supreme Prior and Foundation Director, Sidney Guller, a key supporter of the Foundation.

Fra Guller has increased the opportunities for the Young Scholars Program to reward chapters that make academic success possible for their new members. The chapter with the most Young Scholars in an academic year receives an award of \$1,000. Two awards are given-one for a large chapter and one for a small chapter. Rewarding chapters that value and encourage academic success, as well as Fraternity, is the goal.

These awards were presented at the Convention in Indianapolis and the 2015-16 recipients of the awards for Guller Young Scholars chapters are University of Texas (as pictured on page 4-5), University of California Los Angeles, and Emory special recognition for academic excellence. Each chapter received a grant for \$1,000 to use in promoting high academic standards.


